Update on COVID-19 Vigilance Measures

Dear Members,

Pursuant to the Government's announcement, since there is no substantial rebound or drastic change in the epidemic situation, the second stage of relaxation in social distancing measures will be implemented starting from this coming Thursday, 19 May. The Club will therefore launch the further updated precautionary measures until further notice. The detailed measures are as follows:

1. Sports and Recreational Facilities

- Indoor Jacuzzi, Sauna Room and Steam Room are still closed,
- Members and guests are allowed not to wear masks when they are exercising in indoor sports facilities (including Badminton Courts, Squash Courts, Table Tennis Rooms and Exercise Room) and outdoor sports facilities.
- Karaoke, except dancing activity, will be allowed subject to the regulations and restrictions under Chapter 599F of the Laws of Hong Kong.

2. Restaurants

- Chinese Restaurant and Verbena Café resume normal opening hours,
- Remain maximum 8 persons per table, and the maximum number of persons in a banquet will be raised to 120,
- Each membership can only book a maximum of 3 tables at a time,
- Entertainments in card rooms are resumed subject to the regulations and restrictions under Chapter 599F of the Laws of Hong Kong,
- Both live performance and dancing activity are still not allowed.

3. Group gatherings of more than 4 persons in public places remain prohibited.

Other vigilance measures implemented previously are still in place, including temperature screening, mandatory scanning of "LeaveHomeSafe" venue QR code and "Vaccine Pass"*¹, and pro-actively showing the scanning record or the exemption certificate with QR code to the staff members of the Club for record while entering the Club or other selected premises. In addition, wearing of face masks at all times (except when eating or drinking, showering or doing outdoor & indoor exercises) and maintaining social distancing at least 1.5 metre apart from others are also required.

The Club will continue to closely monitor the epidemic situation and review the various measures as required.

*** 3rd stage of "Vaccine Pass": from 31 May, members and guests aged 12 or above except certain special groups must have received at least 3 doses of COVID-19 vaccine in order to enter the Club premises and/or use any of the facilities.**
