Update on COVID-19 Vigilance Measures

Dear Members,

Pursuant to the Government's latest announcement, the Club will strengthen some of the precautionary measures with effect from Thursday, 10 February, 2022 until further notice:

- 1. The number of persons allowed in group gathering in public areas will be tightened from 4 to 2;
- 2. Restaurants: the maximum number of people per table shall be scaled down to 2 for type C mode of operation and 4 for type D mode of operation.

The Club will continue to closely monitor the epidemic situation and review the various measures as required.

Other vigilance measures implemented previously are still in place, including temperature screening, wearing of face masks (except when consuming food or drink), maintaining social distancing at least 1.5 metre apart from others, mandatory scan "LeaveHomeSafe" venue QR code using "LeaveHomeSafe" mobile application and showing the code scanning record to our security staff before entering the club. As for restaurants, you are required to re-scan the Venue QR Code for the particular venue again per government mandate.

The Management has been directed to enforce all precautionary measures strictly and to take necessary disciplinary measures against non-compliance. Any member found not to be abiding by these restrictions that are for the benefit of our membership and staff, will be called to the General Committee for review. We do apologise for any inconvenience these precautionary measures may cause.
