Update on COVID-19 Vigilance Measures

Dear Members,

Pursuant to the Government's latest announcement, the Club will be taking the following precautionary measures with effect from Thursday, 18 February until further notice:

- Recreational Facilities:
 - All recreational facilities will be reopened subject to relevant requirements and restrictions, except mah-jong activities, karaoke, swimming pools, sauna rooms and steam rooms.
- · Restaurants:
 - No more than 4 people allowed per table.
 - Dinner dine-in will be served until 10:00pm (Last order at 9:00pm).
 - Not accommodate more than 50% of the seating capacity.
- · The Opening Hours of Club to resume as normal.

The Club will continue to closely monitor the epidemic situation and review the various measures as required.

Other vigilance measures implemented previously such as temperature screening, wearing of face masks (except when consuming food or drink) and maintaining social distancing at least 1.5 metre apart from others are still in place. Members are reminded to register their guests' names and contact number and fill out a Travel and Health Declaration Form in advance. You can also use the mobile app to scan the "LeaveHomeSafe" QR code at the main entrance.

The Management has been directed to enforce all precautionary measures strictly and to take necessary disciplinary measures against non-compliance. Any member found not to be abiding by these restrictions that are for the benefit of our membership and staff, will be called to the General Committee for review. We do apologise for any inconvenience these precautionary measures may cause.
